

DIRECTIONS

Travel north from Albuquerque on **I-25** to Bernalillo. Take **Exit 242** and turn west on **NM-44/US-550** to San Ysidro. Turn north on **NM-4** and proceed past Jemez Pueblo 0.25 miles. Turn right on **NM-290**. Travel 7 miles on paved road through Ponderosa Village. Continue on gravel road for 2 miles. Take the left fork in road. Travel a short distance and turn right on **Forest Road #266.** Proceed 1/4 mile. The gate to camp is on the left. (See our website for a map)

NOTES

- 1. Do not bring: iPhone, iPad, cell phone or other electronic devices, firearms, knives, fireworks, tobacco products, alcohol or pets to camp.
- All clothing and belongings should be marked for identification. While the camp takes reasonable precautions, it assumes no responsibility for the camper's personal property.
- 3. All money will be turned in at registration and a Snack Bar Card will be issued. Any money not spent will be returned at the end of the session.
- 4. The camp phone number is (575) 834-7640. Please call your child only in an emergency. Calls home are generally <u>not</u> allowed, but will be collect if made.
- 5. **CAMP INSURANCE** applies to injury due to accident sustained while at camp. Insurance does not cover care for normal illnesses.

Location and Facilities

Ponderosa Christian Camp is located in the Jemez Mountains of New Mexico surrounded by pine trees with a beautiful stream for a boundary. The facilities include cabins with bunk beds, bathhouses with showers, an upgraded kitchen where food is served cafeteria style, dining hall, an outdoor pavilion, a campfire area, basketball and volleyball courts and a large area for outdoor recreation.
